eight foot square hole to a 42 inch depth.

Another work party took place on September 25th. During that session, the tower base was positioned and leveled. Also, rebar was placed in the hole in a grid pattern, and then connected with wire.

Remaining steps are inspection, creation of the form, pouring and curing of the concrete, assembly of the tower sections, and erection.
