Are you still receiving a paper copy of the TELSTAR? Why not consider getting it by email. You'll receive all the latest news about STARS faster. The TELSTAR is posted to the web, emailed, and dropped in the mailbox the same day. In addition, you'll save the extra \$6 charge for printing and postage costs.

Also, when received via the Internet, you can controlclick on anything appearing underlined in blue. Those are hyperlinks that will bring you directly to the mentioned Internet site. This is especially useful in the Contest Calendar section. Those links would have to be copied into your keyboard if you only had a paper/ mailed copy. Perfection is necessary during the copying phase.

Finally, each edition of **TELSTAR** has a "Blue and Underlined" box. In that box is a "sample link". If you check those samples, each one will bring you to an entertaining web site, unrelated to ham radio.
