


### WNY AMATEURS TO BE LIMITED TO 5 WATTS!

In a startling and unprecedented move, the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) will implement limitations on amateur radio activity in Western New York. More specifically, ALL amateur activity will be limited to no more than 5 watts power.

This power limitation will apply to all amateur transmissions originated north of "Line A" as defined in the FCC regulations Part 97. As a



reminder, Line A is defined in <u>Title 47—Part 97</u>, <u>Subpart A</u>, <u>Section 97.3 (a) (30)</u>. The line was created to define an area near the Canadian border, where transmissions are restricted, so as to avoid interference with Canadian radio services. The definition of the line can be found at this official federal website: <u>http://www.ecfr.gov/</u> (select Title 47—Part 97).

Historically, Line A referred to limitations on amateur UHF transmissions. However, effective April 15, 2013, <u>ALL</u> amateur transmissions north of Line A will be limited to 5 watts.

This action is tied to the Canadian government's displeasure with the United States' failure to approve the Keystone Pipeline, a necessary tool for sending Canadian petroleum to the refineries along the Gulf Coast. Other Canadian actions are anticipated, as diplomacy has failed to resolve the problem.

Line A transects Western New York along a straight line from Burbank, Ohio (coordinates 41° N/82°W) to Bangor, Maine (see map). Communities affected include Jamestown, Fredonia, Buffalo, Rochester, Syracuse and Plattsburgh. Unaffected communities include Olean, Watkins Glen, Ithaca, Utica and Albany.

Reactions to this new policy are wide and varied. However, few amateurs are happy with this (Continued on page 5)

change to the Line A provisions.

**Robert Koster, KA2WYE**, upon learning of the new restrictions, declared, "This is war! We will resolve this issue in court."

Linda Jablonski, KC2YMM, when told about the new restrictions sat in stone-faced silence. After a few moments, she said, "This is not fair. My husband (Ed, KC2YMN) and I spent a lot of time and money to purchase state of the art amateur equipment, and to erect a sophisticated antenna tower. And now, all I can work with that equipment is 5 watts?"

Gene Kremzier, N2OBW, head of the Erie County ARES/RACES team was despondent. "How can we provide our communications service to events such as the Ride for Roswell and the Tour de Cure if our members are limited to 5 watts? There's got to be a resolution to this insanity."

**Richard Kingsley, KE2BV**, runs the Penn Yan repeater. The repeater is just north of Line A. "This will require us to relocate the repeater to one of our other properties, just south of Line A," said Kingsley.

Not all amateurs were unhappy. **Roy Butler**, **KC2FSW**, operates a repeater in Arkport, just south of Line A. "This is great! Now our repeater will be the strongest site in Western New York."

Amateur radio organizations are preparing to fight these new restrictions. Progress of their efforts will be announced in *TELSTAR*.

### FEMA GRANT PROGRESS

As we left this topic last month, it was unknown when the federal government's decision would be made. No change to this information has occurred.

Originally, selections of grant recipients were to have been announced in November.

#### **General** Class


