## **BUILD PROJECTS**

The club has been planning to have a club build project. Building something as a club offers us the opportunity to learn together and help each other -- so you'll hopefully end up with a board that will work. There are so many things to build though, so we need your help to decide what to do! Here are some of the options that have been proposed, do any of them seem interesting to you?

#### **D80-150 Oscilloscope**

This is a small digital oscilloscope with a color TFT screen that can be had for about \$25. The kit comes in two versions: one with the difficult-to-solder SMD parts pre-soldered, and one without them pre-soldered. The device requires a 9V power source (not included, a 9V battery works



great) and weighs 100 grams. For more information see the manufacturer's website.

#### **Antenna Analyzer**

Based on the K6BEZ design, this device uses an Arduino and a AD9850 DDS to get an SWR

measurement. The device can scan a range of frequencies and plot them



on a computer. The version that we are looking at is about \$40. The analyzer has a range of 1.6 to 30MHz. You can find more information on this page.

#### **J-Pole Antenna**

A J-Pole antennas are very popular for VHF use as they are easy and inexpensive to make, have a very low angle of radiation, and don't require a ground plane. They can provide about 6dBi of gain and are reported to perform very well. The cost is expected to be about \$2O.

# STARS LICENSING EXAMS

STARS offers licensing exams at 9:00 AM on the third Saturday of each odd-numbered month. The exams are conducted at the Hamburg Memorial Youth Center at 200 Prospect Avenue in Hamburg. Walk-ins are allowed.

Candidates must bring the following items to the exam:

- Legal photo ID (a driver's license is excellent).
- Your SSN or FRN. FRNs can be obtained on the FCC website.
- Current license and/or CSCE, if any, with a non-returnable photocopy of each.
- \$15 in cash, check, or money order.
- Two #2 pencils with erasers, and a pen.

Calculators are permitted, so long as any programming has been cleared.
