

NEW ANTENNA HOOKUP PANEL

A new antenna hookup panel has been installed in the clubhouse. This replaces the old switchbox system. A picture of the system is supplied below. The box was built by our clubhouse chair, Al Mitzo, and is simpler and easier to use than the switchbox system. There are also a number of expansion slots now available for new antennas and radios.
